Catholic Health eVisit basics

- Only one patient per virtual visit is allowed.
- eVisits should be held in a room with good lighting and no distractions.
- Write down a list of questions and the reason for your visit ahead of time.
- Have your current medication list available.
- If you have home medical equipment:
 - ▶ Take your temperature before your eVisit.
 - ▶ Take your blood pressure beforehand.
 - ▶ Diabetic patients should take a finger stick for blood sugar.
- Should you need to show the doctor a specific body part, dress in a way that allows you to do so easily.
- Have relevant pictures or medical reports handy.

Catholic Health eVisit technology tips

- Test your Wi-Fi and internet connections before your eVisit. Close other applications and test your microphone, volume and video.
- Be sure your device is fully charged.
- Have your camera at eye level.
- Visit the Catholic Health eVisit website or download the mobile app for iPhone or Android and click “Register Your Account.” You will be guided through step-by-step instructions.
